Dr. Feulner is Founder of The Heritage Foundation in Washington, D.C., its Chung Ju-yung Fellow and the Chairman of its Asian Studies Center. He is the principal partner in Feulner & Associates, LLC. Ed formerly served as President of The Heritage Foundation, a position he held from 1977-2013, when he retired. Ed built the Heritage Foundation into the largest privately supported public policy research organization ("think tank") in the world, with a staff of more than 250, \$170 million in assets, and an annual budget of more than \$85 million.

Ed holds a B.S. from Regis University (Denver), an M.B.A. from the Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania (Philadelphia), and a Ph.D. from the University of Edinburgh (Scotland). He also held graduate fellowships at the London School of Economics, the Hoover Institution at Stanford University, and Georgetown University.

Ed has received 11 honorary degrees from universities around the world, has served on seven U.S. governmental advisory boards and commissions, was a public Ambassador to the United Nations, served as Special Assistant to the Secretary of Defense, and has served on the Boards of other organizations and universities. President Reagan conferred the Presidential Citizens Medal on Ed. He has been decorated by the governments of the Republic of Korea, the Czech Republic and Taiwan. Ed received the 2012 Bradley Foundation Prize for leadership.

His weekly column is distributed nationally, and Ed is the author of seven books, including *The American Spirit* (2012), and the *New York Times* best-selling *Getting America Right* (Random House: 2006), and a contributor to many others.

Ed and his wife, Linda, live in Alexandria, Virginia and Bethany Beach, Delaware. The couple has two adult children and three grandchildren.
